Treasurer's Report 2020 Season

Financially the club has had a very successful year – coming off the back of the 2018 & 2019 years – our starting position this year was not the best - with 2 outstanding debts to NTRL & Freds Pass of over \$56,000. The current Committee has worked closely with these creditors to mend and strengthen relationships – and both bodies allowed payment plans to assist the club to get back on our feet.

Payment plan with Freds Pass to conclude in April 2021 – current balance remaining \$11,969

Payment Plan with NTRL to conclude September 2021 – current balance remaining \$22,970

All 2020 Season NTRL fees and Electricity charges for this current Season have been paid in full.

Sponsorship & Donations collected this year \$71,117 – and increase of over \$40,000 in sponsorship – an amazing community contribution for a year that was looking quite concerning for all business – the club would not survive without the support our truly valued sponsors and I sincerely thank all our sponsors for their contribution this year. I would like to acknowledge the efforts of our Sponsorship Coordinator – Amy Simpson who continues tirelessly with our sponsors and web site & social media manager Illuminate to give them great value for their contribution. I would also like to make mention to those sponsors that contribute with goods and services donated throughout the year.

Turnover for The Bar and Canteen Sales \$86,838 - an increase of turnover of \$11,950 and a gross profit of \$32,016 (taking into consideration that the canteen expenses also include the players game day drinks) this is a fantastic effort and I thank all volunteers throughout the year who have spent tireless hours ensuring that the canteen and bar remained open.

The introduction of the "Bears Wear" on-line store was a huge success with over \$11,000 in merchandise sales going through the on-line store option — again a big thank you to Amy Simpson who managed all our merchandise sales and packing and posting of orders and ensuring that everyone was kitted out with uniforms, 30th Anniversary apparel and fishing shirts. Merchandise sales totaled just over \$40,000 this year — an increase of \$36,000 on last year.

Grants awarded this year \$1750 from Litchfield council which assisted with the costs of the 30th Anniversary production – thank you to Leanne Barnes for co-ordinating this was very well received by all our members and supporters. A second grant of \$4455 has been awarded to assist with shade structure and also to train our Coaches, managers & sports trainers with required certifications. Due to COVID first aid courses were not available throughout the year – this will see us being able to offer training at no cost to a greater number of our volunteers next year to keep our players safe.

Now to the bank balanceI can confirm that the closing balance as at 31 October was \$117,678 in both Bendigo accounts – taking away outstanding debts - \$34,939, Money held for Grants that have not yet been expensed: \$14,455 – has club sitting in a positive cash position at \$99,724.

I would like to thank the 2020 Committee who have worked hard to make the 30th Anniversary Year such a success it was been an absolute pleasure working with all of you.
